### Internship Experience:

PlainSong Music Services, LLC is a **private practice** located in Anderson, IN. The practice serves 8 counties in central Indiana. Our team of **15 therapists** work with a variety of populations including **intellectual and developmental disabilities, hospice, memory care, substance abuse, mental health, and more!** Interns can expect to work with 3 board-certified music therapists in order to gain various experiences and learn different styles and techniques. A **full-time internship** will include 40 hours of office work per week, which includes **22-25 direct hours** with clients, time to complete assignments, and time for supervision. Interns will also be expected to complete homework assignments outside of office hours. Interns will observe, co-lead, and lead **individual sessions, small groups, and large groups**. After sessions (as time allows), the intern will have time to receive immediate feedback from the supervising therapist as well as ask any questions. Interns will also participate in a minimum of one hour of **formal supervision** with their supervisor each week. This will be a time to reflect on the week and prepare for the next week.

### Music Therapy Process:

At PlainSong, we believe in creating **individualized goals** for each client that aids them in reaching their full potential inside and outside of music therapy. We tailor sessions to meet the needs of each individual and the family. PlainSong is **community-focused**, and we work hard to make our presence felt. Interns will be trained to facilitate sessions, advocate for clients and the music therapy profession, lead presentations in the community, and engage in **community advocacy events**. Interns will participate in quarterly meetings with interdisciplinary team members, program development meetings with prominent members of the community, and other community engagement meetings. Interns will also complete homework assignments designed to broaden and enhance clinical skills and prepare for the CBMT exam.
